

Fulvica - What is Fulvica?

Fulvica contains natural humic acids (including fulvic and humic acids) derived from the organic matter found between peat and leonardite rocks. We do not use preservatives, sugars, sweeteners or dyes. Suitable in a vegan and vegetarian diet.
